

Toyota continues Hurricane Sandy clean-up commitment

Four months after Hurricane Sandy struck the US, Toyota is continuing to place resources at the disposal of local communities trying to recover and rebuild from the catastrophe.

In their most recent donation, the company passed on 19 Toyota vehicles to the Red Cross in the region for one year, providing vital transportation for the organisation. Saint Paul's United Methodist Church will also receive a 4Runner SUV to be used in local clean-up efforts.

Last year, Toyota donated \$1 million to the relief efforts needed in the wake of Hurricane Sandy and donated five vehicles. Assistant general manager for Toyota's New York region Steve Haag said, "We understand the ongoing need for Hurricane Sandy relief aid and we want to make sure the community knows they are still being supported four months after the disaster."
