Close to the "Aegean Team", close to Greece's remote islands

For one more year, Mellon Group of Companies remained close to the "Aegean Team" (Omada Aigaiou) that works for the assistance and relief of the inhabitants of the remote islands of Greece. The "Aegean Team" continuing its valuable contribution, carried out the 16th Annual Sailing of the Aegean Sea, between the 13th and the 27th of May 2010. Utilizing the ambulance vessel "Minas E", which is outfitted with state of the art medical equipment for preventive medicine, full medical exams of various specialities were conducted on adults and children.

The number of examinations during this Sailing was the biggest ever, whereas some necessary minor operations were conducted. Moreover, the team offered valuable pedagogic and educational materials, while important infrastructure projects were inaugurated in some of the islands. From our side, we remain faithful advocates of this effort, providing financial support, but also with the active participation of the Managing Director of the Group in the annual Sailing.

BiLiveStrong

Our subsidiary in Skopje, Mellon Solutions, undertook a leading role in the realization of the initiative "Bilivestrong", a non-governmental organization which was founded by the friends of a young woman with leukemia, in order to cover the expenses of her therapy.

Both the company and the employees participated by purchasing tickets to a fund raising concert, by providing telephone lines dedicated to donations, as well as by selling specially branded T-shirts to supporters of the initiative.

Social Contribution

In early fall 2010 we raised money through a fund raiser among the companies of the Group based in Greece in support of the non-governmental organization "Smile of the Child" (Hamogelo tou Paidiou).

With the collected amount we purchased significant quantities of basic goods for the 275 children hosted in the organization's shelter homes.

Likewise, the companies deposited an amount equivalent to this raised by the employees, to cover other needs of the organization.

Following the devastating earthquake in Haiti early in 2010, we raised money among employees and deposited the amount to a dedicated bank account, as a minor contribution to the relief of the residents of the island.

Our subsidiary in Sofia, Mellon Bulgaria, offered financial support by sponsoring the annual bazaar of the International Women's Club (IWC), a charity organization with emphasis on the needs of women.

And as always, we augment our Christmas wishes by purchasing our corporate Christmas cards from non-profit organizations.





Volunteerism: Beneficial for All

Through our communication with non-governmental organizations, it was made obvious to us that very often offering volunteer work is as important as providing financial aid.

We thus proceeded with the creation of a team of Mellon volunteers to assist NGOs in different activities for which help was required.

Among the first activities of the team was to assist the "Smile of the Child" organization in sorting out foods and clothes received through donations, and in creating 'bobonieres' (traditional sugar almond sweets distributed as souvenirs at weddings and christenings), which represent a significant revenue stream for the organization.

An adjacent benefit to Mellon's volunteerism rests in the creation of a sense of participation and contribution by the members of the team, as well as in the cultivation of a team spirit.



For over a decade now, the Greek companies of Mellon have been maintaining a blood bank for the employees and their first degree relatives. Indicatively, during 2010, more than 10 bottles of blood were requested.

The companies of the Group organize various events, such as the Christmas or New Year's parties for employees and their children.



WEEE Directive


